Behavior Analysis Undergraduate Verified Course Sequence for the
Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst Credential

Only the IN-PERSON, on-campus courses are part of a Behavior Analyst Certification Board® (BACB) Verified Course Sequence (VCS). ONLINE courses are NOT part of the FIU VCS. Please see the BACB® policy on courses taken outside of a VCS.

As of fall 2014, the undergraduate behavior analysis VCS, needed to fulfill the coursework requirements for taking the Board Certified Associate Behavior Analyst (BCaBA) exam, consists of the course below. The VCS meets BACB® requirements for certification under the BACB 4th Edition Task List. Courses are open to all FIU students, regardless of major or degree-seeking status. **No Course Substitutions Are Allowed.**

- EAB 3002 Introduction to the Experimental Analysis of Behavior (3 credits). Prerequisites: PSY 2012
*Note: This is a prerequisite course for the remaining courses and may not be taken concurrently with any other course in the sequence. **Students are eligible to begin supervised experience upon enrolling in EAB 3002. Additional information will be sent via your FIU email.***
- EAB 4794 Principles and Theories of Behavior Modification (3 credits). Prerequisite: EAB3002
Note: May be taken concurrently with EAB 4798 or PSY 4931
- EAB 3764* The Application of Behavior Analysis to Child Behavior Problems (3 credits). Prerequisite: EAB3002
Note: May be taken concurrently with EAB 4798 or PSY 4931
** The course number was changed from 3765 to 3764 in fall 2018. Course content did not change.*
- EAB 4798 Single Case Research Methods (3 credits). Prerequisite: EAB 3002
Note: May be taken concurrently with EAB 4794 or EAB 3764 or PSY 4931
- PSY 4931: Senior Seminar in Behavior Analysis (3 credits). Prerequisite: EAB 4798 & EAB 4794 or EAB 3764
*Note: May be taken concurrently with EAB 4798 or EAB 3764. Prerequisites may be waived, at the discretion of the instructor, for non-psychology majors and non-degree seeking students only. Prerequisites **may not be waived** for psychology majors. **Only sections with the description "Behavior Analysis" are part of the VCS.***

RECOMMENDED SCHEDULES: Students who wish to take more than one course in the sequence during a single semester should do so in an order consistent with one of the schedule options below. Taking more than two courses concurrently is discouraged.
